Today, emerging markets serve as the world's economic growth engine and the far-reaching effects continue to play out. Neil Gregory will discuss the evolution of emerging markets over the next 8 years based on key structural trends impacting those markets.

Neil Gregory is Chief Strategy Officer for Investment Operations at the IFC. He was previously Chief of Strategy and Operations for the World Bank Group's Financial and Private Sector Development Network, which produces global benchmarking products which include *Doing Business*. Before that he was a Manager in IFC's South Asia Department with responsibility for investment strategy and advisory services. Earlier in his career, he was Adviser to the UK Executive Director of the IMF and World Bank Group and an Economic Adviser to the UK government. He holds economics degrees from Cambridge and Oxford and an MBA from Georgetown's McDonough School of Business.
